### Contest Rules and Prizes:

**Knives and Hawks must meet "modified" NMLRA rules:** Hawk blade can have maximum width of 4" measured straight across bit, from point to point). Knives must have a natural handle and at least one cutting edge. Contestants have five (5) throws each with knife and hawk for a combined score. Both must complete one full turn before striking target. All targets must be posted on official blocks designated by contest judges.

Entry Fee: Entry fee is \$2.00. All registration ends one (1) hour before show closing each day. Open to all ages: 12 & up. Age 15 and under must be accompanied by an adult. One Prize will be awarded each day to the high scorer - a miniature engraved brass hawk blade. All Judges' Decisions Are Final. In case of a tie (during championship only), competitors will have a throw-off.

Only the highest daily scorers may return to compete in Saturday's Throw-off

1<sup>st</sup>: Place: \$100 and an Engraved Pewter Mug

2<sup>nd</sup> Place: \$50

**Non-competitors will be able to try their luck at tomahawk throwing** at specified times during the week. Equipment and instructions, if needed, will be supplied by the Pennsylvania Federation of Muzzleloaders. There will be a daily prize given away to the top attendee tomahawk throw. From the opening of the show till 5:30 we will keep track of the best throw by an attendee. The person who has the top throw that day will get a tomahawk.
